SUBJECT: RESULT NOMINATION CALL - RMTU NATIONAL PRESIDENT

At the close of nominations for National President, there were two (2) correctly completed and therefore "live" nominations.

The nominees are;

Aubrey Wilkinson – Incumbent National President and Crane Driver Port of Tauranga
Kasia Kurene - Mechanical Engineer and HASAT Chair at Hutt Workshops KiwiRail

The duties of the National president are stated in Rule 27 of the RMTU Rules and Standing Orders.

In accordance with Rule 42 of the RMTU Rules and Standing Orders the NMC have determined by majority vote that for the election of President, General Secretary and NMC in 2019 if a postal ballot is required for two candidates that it be under the provision of Rule 42, "a full membership secret postal ballot by the members be conducted by the national returning officer with the papers being issued out of the national office to members postal addresses and that the successful candidate be identified by a simple majority of votes". "If a ballot is required and there are more than two candidates then the voting be by preferential voting method as per Rule 42.4"

It is anticipated that voting papers will have been deposited with NZ Post by Friday 3 May 2019 and that the ballot will close on Friday 24 May at 1700hrs. The Union's postal box will be cleared on Monday 27 May in the early am and any ballots in there will be included within the voting.
