## **Meeting Agenda**

1. Distribute the fact sheets, template submission and postcards to those present at the meeting.
2. Discussion of fact sheet sections – delegate to facilitate discussion about what the Bill would mean for workers in this workplace and the impact it would have on relationships within the workplace.
3. Discussion about issues or stories that can be added to the template submission or provided for the main RMTU submission from the workplace.
4. Meeting with local MP. Who is the National, United, NZ First or Maori Party MP in your area? Would members like to arrange a meeting with them to discuss our opposition to the Bill.
5. Decision about who will liase with local MP's office to arrange meeting.
6. Any further discussion about how to ensure members in the workplace are aware of the impact of the Bill on New Zealand employees.
7. Take a list of names and contact details of people interested in further involvement in the campaign. Such involvement might include appearing before the Select Committee, meeting with MPs if handy to Wellington or one of the city centres visited by the Select Committee.
8. Fill out the meeting report sheet and return to the RMTU National Office.
