# Toll bought out Western Stevedores December 2004.

- In purchasing Western Stevedores, Toll Ports acquired a network of operations, from Esperance, Albany, Fremantle, Geraldton and Dampier, with an interest in branching as far north as Port Hedland and Darwin.

# All operations for Toll are as follows:

- Fremantle: (Bulk & General)
- Karratha: (Dampier public wharf). This port is the major port for transport to the offshore industry. Largest in Australia for work offshore. Mermaid Marine lay down area in Dampier, Toll have also gone into a joint venture with Mermaid's.
- Albany: At the moment Bulkwest is the stevedore in Albany, but is up for sale. All indications point to Toll as acquiring it. Potential growth in woodchip yard that Toll has acquired.
- Geraldton: Indications from Port Authority is that Toll will be the main stevedore in this port.

# MEMBERS:

- All Toll Maritime operations in W.A. are covered by an enterprise agreement. That agreement will expire on 30 June 2005 and negotiations are taking place at present.
- Permanents are to be increased to 15, GWE's status to change to TIPE and there will be a total of 15 TIPE's. Supplementaries to remain as they are in Fremantle.
